

2015 Manistee County Food Pantries

MATTHEW 25:35 Food Pantry – St. Joseph Catholic Church, Manistee, Michigan and St. Joseph Community Food Pantry, Onekama, Michigan

General: The purpose of these two food pantries is to respond to families and individuals who are residents of Manistee County, low income and in need of food assistance. **Recipients can attend either pantry, but not both in the same month.**

The Matthew 25:35 pantry is open the 2nd Friday of each month from 10:00 Am to 12 :00 noon.

The St. Joseph Community Food Pantry, Onekama is open the 4th Friday of the month from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM.

Recipients must sign in to receive food.

Only one person per household/residence can receive household food for each month.

No smoking on church property.

No animals allowed in the building.

Fraud, unsupervised children or rudeness will not be tolerated.

AT REGISTRATION YOU WILL RECEIVE A “LINE CARD” THAT YOU MUST BRING WITH YOU EACH TIME YOU ATTEND EITHER PANTRY. This card is good for both pantries.

Requirements: Must have proof that you are a Manistee County Resident. A picture ID, utility bill or rent receipt will be acceptable verification. You must be low income based on 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines (guidelines are posted in the registration area of the food pantry).
