"but at your command I will lower the nets."

Dear Friends in Christ, I told you last week that I am going to talk a little more, these days, about the beatitudes. I would like you to understand these teaching of our Lord deeply. These Sundays gave me the opportunity to see and show you how beautiful our God is with us. Last week, I told you that the essence of the beatitudes is the unconditional love and Jesus came for this reason to teach us how to love.

In our readings of this Sunday, we heard that people were crowding around Jesus to listen to the word of God. We see Jesus going out among the people, into the streets, meeting them where they were and entering into their everyday lives. God created this world for us to make us happy! From the book of Genesis, we heard that this revelation that God loves us. Next week we are going to hear part of the beatitudes according to Luke. But, to live this new way that Jesus taught us we need a fundamental attitude that our reading today is given us.

We heard in our Gospel today that the apostles had already washed their nets in preparation for the next day and were plainly exhausted, disappointed and ready to just give it up for the day. But Peter, in the act of obedience says, OK, if you say so I'll do it. Nothing more than that, just simple obedience to Jesus. This is very interesting that we need to pay attention and see in our lives how we are responding to Jesus when He is asking us to do something. I certainly have times when I am totally worn out, tired, times when I hope the ringing phone is not one of the fellow brothers asking me to do something right away. The readings of this Sunday help us to understand that acting on Jesus' command, the nets are raised and are overfilled with fish. So many that another boat is needed to hold the catch. For me caught my attention Peter's response to the miracle of abundance was to protest that he is unworthy because he is a sinful man.

In today's Old Testament reading, Isaiah is in the presence of God and is being called by God to take a message to God's people. Isaiah protests and says "Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of Hosts!"

Both Isaiah and Peter feel the magnitude of their unworthiness. But they felt the power of God in their lives that the follow the command of God. Now, my brothers and sisters in this week I would like to invite you to hear the voice of God in your lives and follow what God is asking you to do! God knows in what way we can serve Him and He can produce a miracle to show his glory and power.
