

## LECTOR INSTRUCTIONS

The Sunday, 11:00 AM Mass at St. Joseph is experimenting with the use of 2 Lectors at Mass. The Liturgy Committee will be evaluating this to determine if we continue or even expand this to other Masses. Beginning Sunday, 10/14/18, any Lector, not assigned to read on that day, may ask the assigned Lector to do the second reading at that Mass.

The assigned Lector for the Mass will process; enter the sacristy at the proper time for the first reading; read; remove the book from atop the Ambo to the shelf; exit the sacristy.

The assigned Lector will also later read the petitions.

The second reader will **not** process and will only enter the sacristy after the Psalm is completed. The second reader is to close and move the book to the shelf on the Ambo.

Lectors should only read twice in the month (one as assigned, the other as secondary if desired.)

Assigned Lectors should try to partner with a different second Lector each time to provide diversity.

If you are acting as a Lector, you should not perform a second service at that Mass. Please take that Sunday off from sitting with the choir.
